**IMPORTANT - TRANSFERS** of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (Ch. 11 Section 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show. TRANSFERS OF DOGS IN OBEDIENCE/RALLY CLASSES (Ch. 1 Section 16 of Obedience Regulations) The request for transfers must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers for Obedience may be approved, provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

All persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the clubs or their members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

## Best Puppy in Show Competition

For Puppy Dogs and Bitches ~ 6 & under 9 months and 9 & under 12 months

The puppy class winner in each breed/variety will be judged immediately following Best of Breed/Variety to determine Best Puppy for that breed/variety. An entry in the puppy class that is awarded Best of Breed/Variety or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Puppy for that breed/variety. The Best of Breed/Variety Puppy Winners will compete in their respective groups for First through Fourth place. Best Puppy in Show will be selected from the seven group winners.

---

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Lagotti Romagnoli, American Water Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cimechi dell'Etna, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei and Chow Chows. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.

---

### NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.

**Dogs May Arrive** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

**Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

**All Dogs Present** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**No gasoline or diesel generators** are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

**As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4** of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**The Club and its Superintendent** caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in the premium list and assumes all risks involved.

**No commercial videotaping on show grounds except by prior arrangement with Chairpersons.**

**All rights to TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE** or otherwise exploit these events are vested in the clubs or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the clubs. All persons and animals on the show grounds at anytime while the events are in progress do, by attending these events or participating therein, grant to the clubs the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent. The clubs are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these events.

### ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

There will be a Zero Tolerance Policy at the Cranberry Cluster for poor manners, verbal abuse, foul language or damages to property at hotels/motels and/or the fairgrounds. Any mistreatment of fairgrounds or show personnel, club members or show volunteers will result in an Event Committee Hearing. Thank you for your cooperation.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

**Motor Homes** - By reservation only. Parking will be available from 1:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. on Wednesday. Campers arriving after Wednesday may access the hookup area inside the gate only before 7:30 A.M. or after 5:30 P.M. **Cost is \$25.00 a day. Camper hookups are available for an additional \$30.00 per day. BCAS is charging the Cluster \$35.00 per day for hookups.** 10' maximum between campers. Saving spaces and using cones will not be allowed. **An additional fee of \$25.00 will be charged for any RV without a reservation, if space is available.**

**Anyone plugging into electric hookups** who has not paid for them in advance will be subject to a **\$50.00 per day charge** for each day they are on the grounds.

**No grooming tables, x-pens, or setups in specialty parking** due to space constraints.

**Parking** in designated areas only.

**Limited Handicapped Parking** available only with valid placard or license plate.

**Unloading** in designated area only and park vehicle outside gate.

**Overnight & Day of Show Parking are privileges.** Failure to obey any rules and/or disrespect for the BCAS, Town or Club Personnel may result in an Event Committee Hearing. Your cooperation will assure continued use of BCAS Fairgrounds. The clubs reserve the right to withdraw privileges without return of any parking or entry fees paid.

**Please cooperate with all parking personnel.** If necessary, vehicles may be towed at owner's expense.

**Exhibitor/Handler Courtesy** - All will be expected to keep the Fairgrounds clean by using the barrels and dumpster provided. Please do not leave anything behind to be picked up.

**Grooming tent available on Wednesday after 5:00 P.M. or after tent company has completed setup of Grooming Tent.** Please **stack** crates and respect aisles. No mats, chairs or x-pens please. No saving spaces. All generators in marked area only.

**No crates, grooming tables, x-pens, strollers or motorized vehicles** (scooters, carts, etc.) in ring tent or aisles.

**Any equipment left overnight, unless in prime reserved area or grooming tent will be moved.** The Event Committees reserve the right to move equipment under tents if necessary or in violation of rules.

**Canine Courtesy** - All dogs shall be kept under control at all times to maximize safety to other exhibitors and their dogs. No unentered dogs will be allowed on the show grounds. Dogs cannot be left on the grounds overnight unattended.

**Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.**

**All dogs present are required to have current vaccination** against Parvo, Distemper and Rabies. Any dogs, in the veterinarian's opinion, which exhibit clinical signs of any of these diseases, will be removed from the Fairgrounds. **A current rabies certificate must be presented upon request.**

**Parents** must be responsible for their children.

**Groups** may be judged simultaneously at the discretion of the Event Committee and/or the Superintendent.

**Trophies** not awarded in the ring may be obtained at the Trophy Table during the show and prior to Best in Show judging. **Trophies will not be mailed.**

**Declaration of Entries** - Entries of exhibitors with unpaid entries, will be removed from previous shows may be declined.

**Returned checks** will be assessed a **\$25.00 returned check fee** in addition to the initial amount owed.

**The Clubs and BCAS** assume no responsibility for any injury, loss or damage sustained by a spectator, exhibitor or his dog or for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these events.

**Admission** - Adults, \$5.00; Children under 12, \$2.00.

**Food** will be available. Chairs will not be provided.

## DAY PRIME PARKING RESERVATION
